

**Access and Affordability Question: 123**

Today health care costs are increasing as coverage is decreasing. What specific actions will you take to ensure that Ohioans have coverage for the health care they need at an affordable price?

**Employer Based Health Care**

Employer-provided health care is costing businesses more yet providing less coverage for employees.
